One of the highlights of this portion of the tour was the magic show given by Sandy Pottinger in the CALS Administration Services office. Thank you, Sandy, Steve Crofts, Randy Ryan, Elaine Marchello, and Debby Janes for guiding tours of the CALS Administrative offices.

The tour then headed outdoors with the director of the Campus Arboretum, Libby Davison. Libby gave an hour long tour of several beautiful and interesting trees on campus. Each tree offered a fun story of how it arrived on campus. In addition, Libby talked about how the campus landscape has changed over the years. Libby's tour was both highly enjoyable and very informative.

Our tour attendees ended the morning portion of their tour having lunch with the CALS Staff Council and Dean Sander.

The afternoon of the tour took a different route from past tours, but kept as our first stop one of the most popular visits to the CEAC Greenhouse Facilities. Dr. Pat Rorabough explained to us how the carbon dioxide is monitored in the greenhouses and how the vine type plants are hoisted up on a rail to maintain their height without spreading out all over the greenhouse area. Since it was a nice fall day we then walked over to the Pima County Extension office for a colorful tour of the garden area led by Master Gardener, Nancy McCue. The roses were in full bloom making a delightful stroll through the archway towards a satellite dish containing a multitude of plants. After a refreshing sit down in the cool Ramada and enjoying the refreshments provided by Chris Hiemstra, we loaded the van to the A.R.C. - Agricultural Research Complex for a tour with Dr. Bob Collier. Exciting things in research are occurring here in the field of heat stress on livestock. This amazing facility can set up a controlled environment selecting the humidity, heat and light needed to run their experiments with live animals. An exciting end to the tour was the "Moon base Greenhouse Lab" where Dr. Gene Giacomelli and Lane Patterson showed us the portable greenhouse which could be condensed to travel to the moon, then expanded once there and placed at the poles of the moon underground. They are also using this Moon base environment as a project to determine the sustainability of plants in limited spaces here on earth. It was a full day and a delight to meet and get to know some of the CALS staff, the variety of facilities as well as the research personnel. RM & TC
