Crop sales accounted for \$2,229,927 of the total value in 2002.

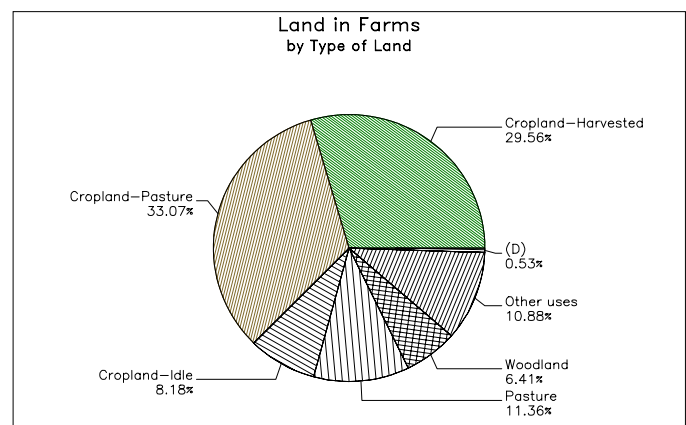
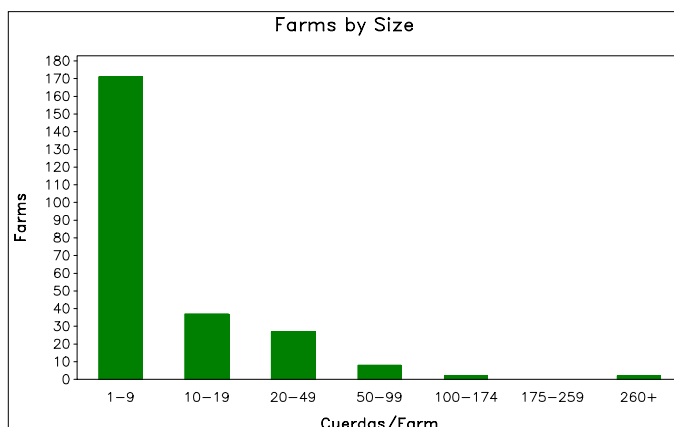
Livestock sales accounted for \$475,939 of the total value in 2002.
