Crop sales accounted for \$6,288,382 of the total value in 2002.

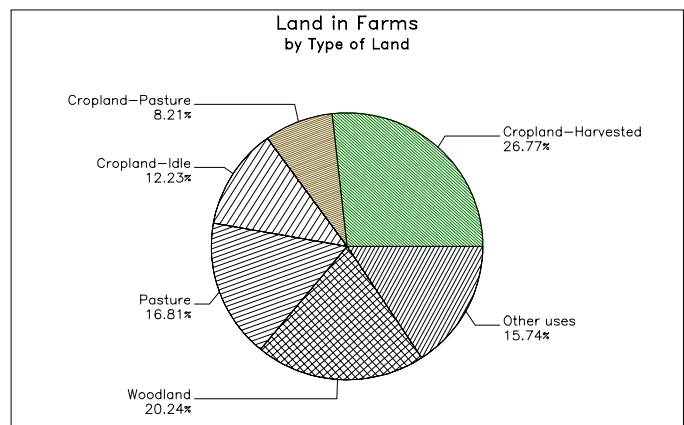
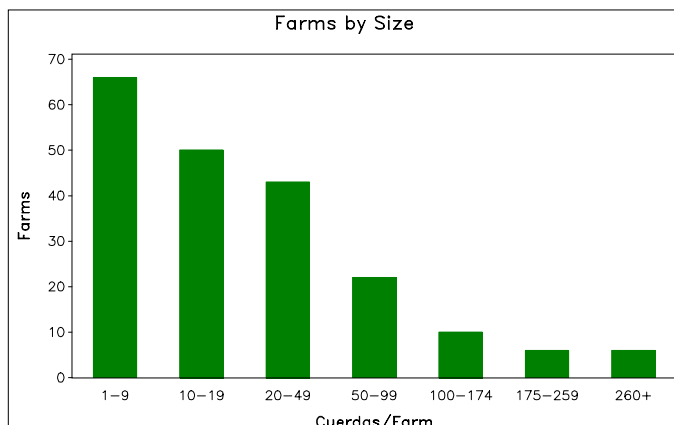
Livestock sales accounted for \$816,503 of the total value in 2002.
