Crop sales accounted for \$1,102,571 of the total value in 2002.

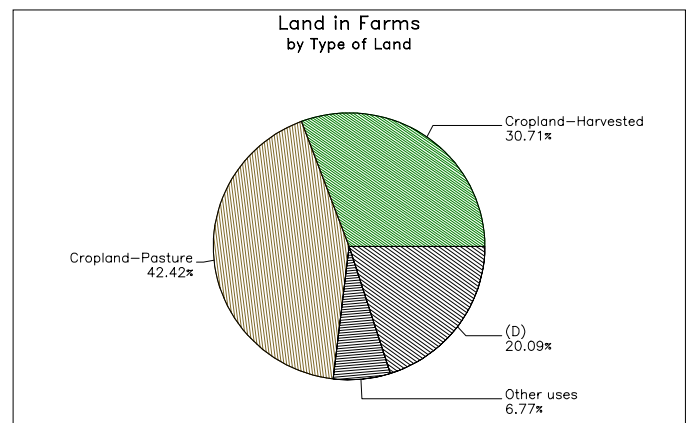
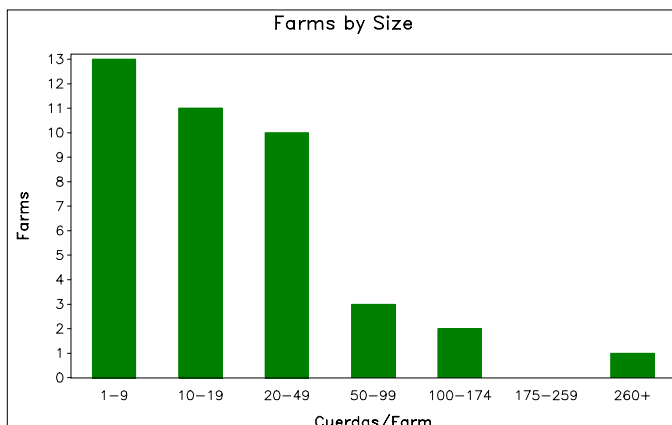
