Crop sales accounted for \$2,741,635 of the total value in 2002.

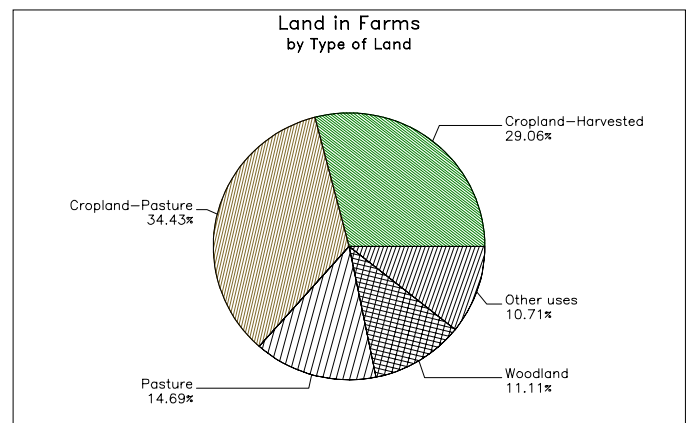
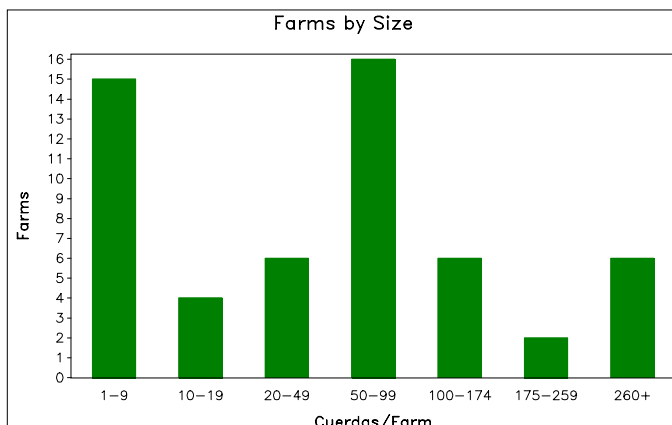
