Crop sales accounted for \$5,267,575 of the total value in 2002.

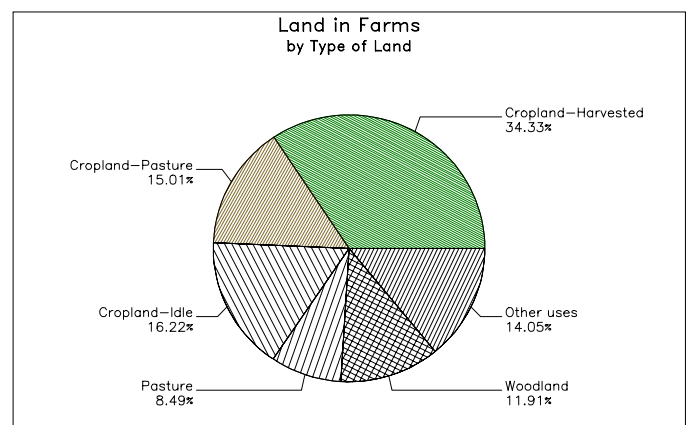
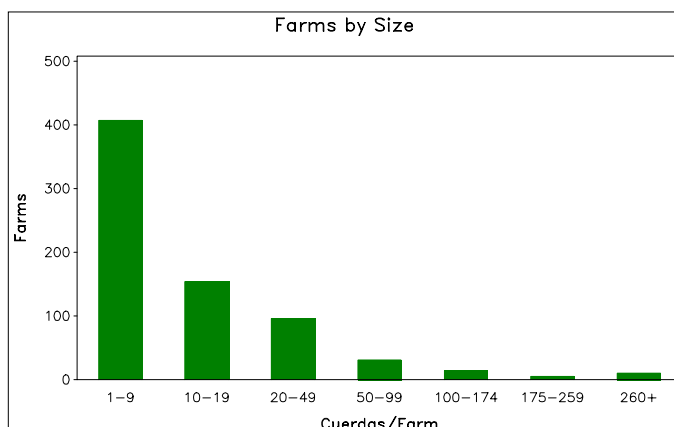
Livestock sales accounted for \$946,423 of the total value in 2002.
