Crop sales accounted for \$1,550,495 of the total value in 2002.

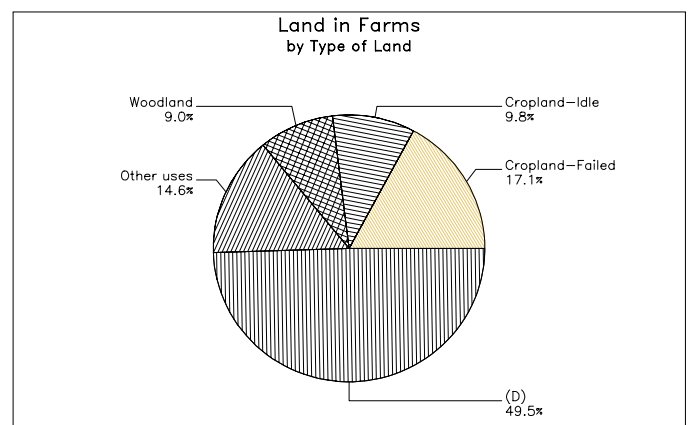
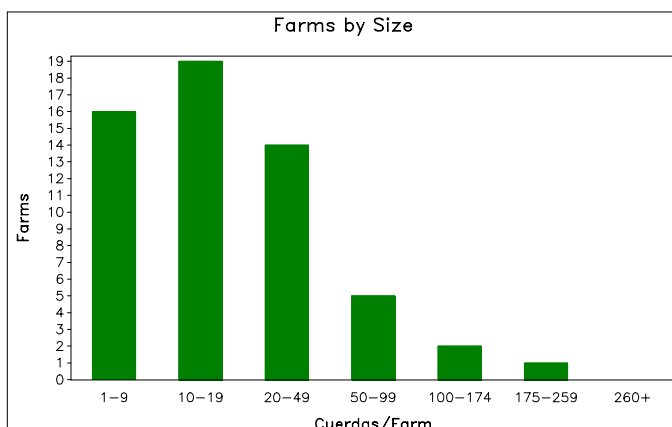
