Dear Producer:

**Did you suffer crop losses in the last three years? If so, read this letter carefully. You may be eligible for a disaster payment from the Farm Service Agency (FSA)!**

According to USDA records, you had purchased crop insurance for the 2005, 2006, and/or 2007 crop years and thus, may now be eligible to receive benefits from FSA's Crop Disaster Program (CDP). Congress has made this program available to producers who either have insured their applicable crop with a federal crop insurance policy or obtained coverage from FSA's Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program.

Under the 2005 – 2007 CDP, you may receive benefits for one of these years if you were prevented from planting a crop or suffered crop losses due to a natural disaster. These benefits may be provided even if you did not receive an indemnity and is in addition to any amounts you received from crop insurance. Crop losses could be either quantity losses in excess of 35% or quality losses in excess of 25%, as determined by FSA. In order to apply for benefits, the program application (FSA-840), production records and leases (if necessary), marketing contracts (optional), and other required forms must be filed at the FSA office.

If you are interested in applying for benefits under this program, you must file an application at your local FSA office before the end of the signup period (to be announced). Contact your FSA office to make an appointment to discuss your eligibility for this program or to obtain additional information. You may also access the FSA website ([www.fsa.usda.gov](http://www.fsa.usda.gov)) for more information. California FSA office locations are provided on the reverse side of this letter.
