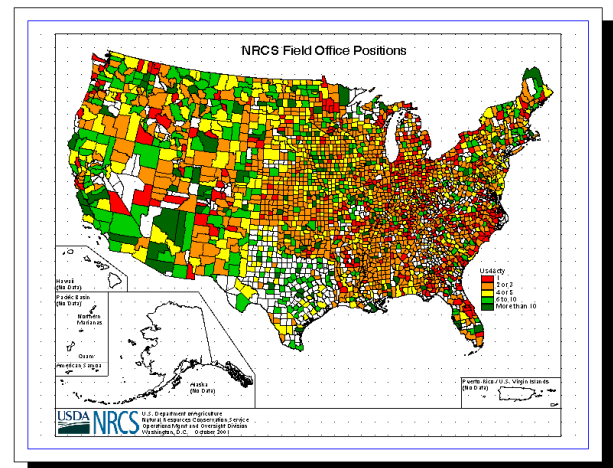
What is the Workload Management system?

The Workload Management System was first used in FY1999 to collect State information concerning their staff and priority work. WMS provides data describing where NRCS and the Conservation Partnership staff are located, and the major resource concerns facing the counties. The Workload Management was updated in FY2001.



What is its purpose?

The States identified all funded positions; the location of the position, county or counties the person served; and if the position was filled or vacant. The partnership data collected are the primary source of information on partnership staff contributions human resources toward completing conservation practices.
