indemnity payments, insured farmers who are concerned about the impact of Asian soybean rust must use good farming practices and follow recommendations of local agricultural experts, such as agricultural extension agents, or other local experts, to control this fungus. Farmers should also talk with their crop insurance companies about complying with the terms of their crop insurance policies. While disease is an insured peril under the Federal Crop Insurance Program, damage due to the insufficient or improper application of available disease control measures is not. In all cases, it is essential for insured farmers to **document** recommendations they received and actions they took to combat this disease.
