The Kansas City Commodity Office (KCCO) today announced the award of Commodity Exchange 5I, dated August 21, 2007. CCC will exchange 1,003,029.78 bushels of CCC owned bulk corn for 7,053 metric tons of corn-soy blend packaged in 25kg hp bags delivered to Jacintoport, TX. The corn-soy blend is for the McGovern-Dole Food for Education Program.
