Swett Ranch: Open May 23rd and 24th. (Swett Ranch will be open Saturdays and Sundays only for the season). Ute Fire Lookout Tower: Closed for season due to necessary repairs.

FLAMING GORGE RESERVOIR AND GREEN RIVER

Full reservoir is 6,040 feet. Current elevation is 6,021 feet. The releases are currently steady at 835 CFS. They will remain at this level until spring runoff operations begin.
