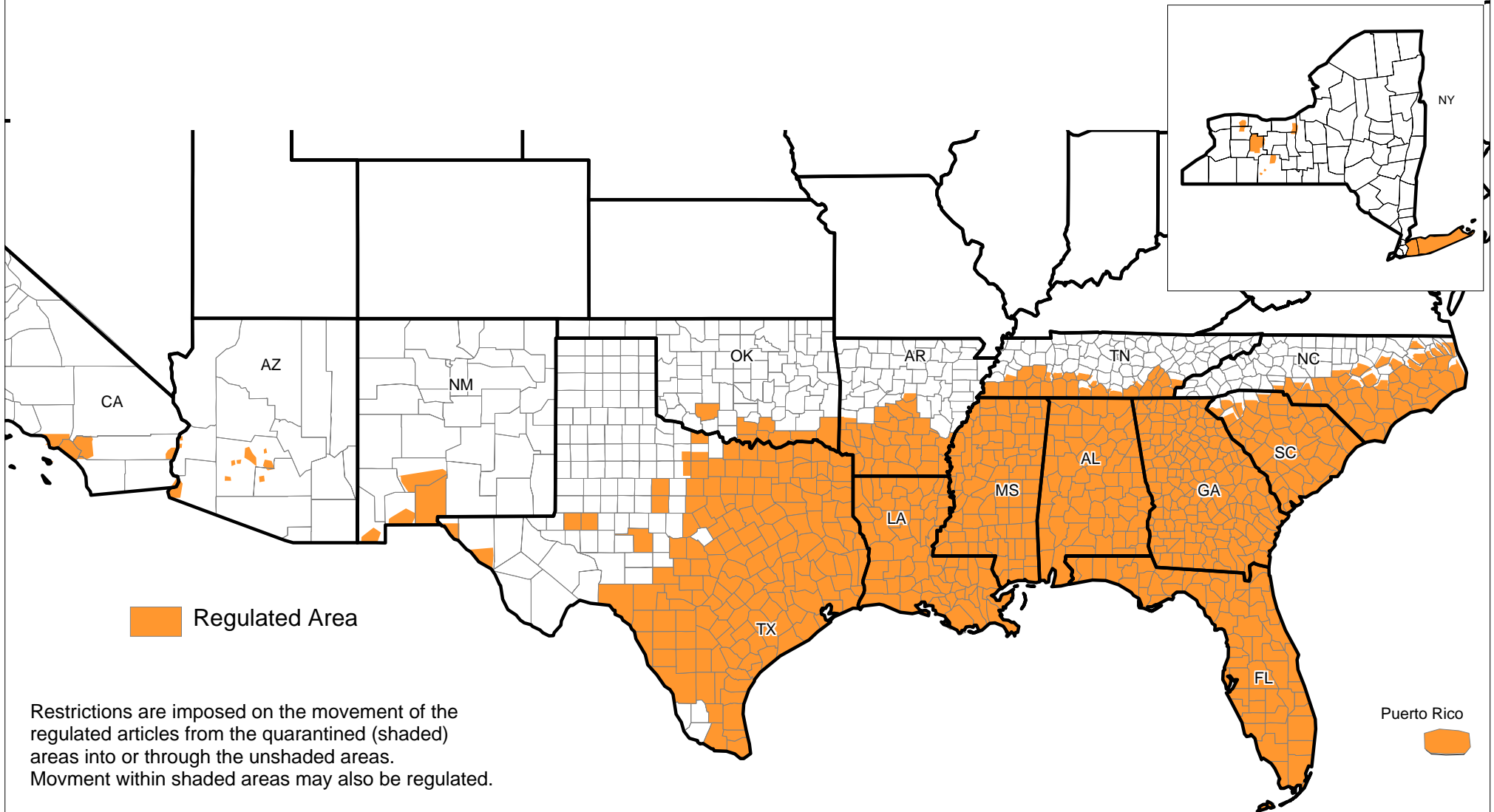


Soil Movement Regulations



Restrictions are imposed on the movement of the regulated articles from the quarantined (shaded) areas into or through the unshaded areas. Movement within shaded areas may also be regulated.

Consult your State or Federal plant protection inspector or your county agent for assistance regarding exact areas under regulation and requirements for moving regulated articles.

Federal soil movement regulations are designated to stop the human-assisted spread of agricultural pests such as imported fire ant, golden nematode, karnal bunt, witchweed, and Mexican fruit fly.

There are other soil borne organisms of state quarantine significance (not listed on this map) which may require certification for movement at origin. Prior to movement, consult with destination states concerning their entry requirement for soil.
