Farm Bill Implementation

- ".....Although the Administration has had significant policy differences with the Congress over the wisdom of many of the provisions in the new Farm Bill, it is now the law of the land. We have each taken an oath to faithfully execute the law, and so it is now time to end the debate, roll up our sleeves, and get to work implementing the new legislation....." - Teams are working to expedite rulemaking by:
 - Reviewing provisions
 - Proposing action plans for implementing provisions
- Process will be open and transparent

Farm Bill 2008

• Two titles affect Rural Development:

-Title VI – Traditional provisions, including
Broadband, Community Programs, Business Programs \$150 Million Mandatory Funding

-**Title IX** – Energy provisions - **\$905 Million** Mandatory Funding (to be administered by RD)
