MEMORANDUM FOR: Licensee Point of Contact

**REFERENCE**: DOJ Non-Disclosure Agreement

Prior to the distribution of any information on Department of Justice (DOJ) Systems currently operating in the 1710-1755 MHz band, the DOJ requires the requesting Licensee and any of their authorized representatives to fill out and sign the attached Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA). This NDA is of standard format, and is being required from all Licensees and their authorized representatives who have, or are expected to request and receive system or spectrum related information from the DOJ.

The purpose of this NDA is to protect against unauthorized disclosure of certain non-public, sensitive-but-unclassified DOJ information which the DOJ believes could harm or impede investigative activities, techniques, and/or capabilities that might adversely impact or impair DOJ operations. It should be noted that in accordance with the attached NDA, "*each employee*" (licensee or licensee designee) that is anticipated to require exposure to DOJ information, is required to sign a copy of an Exhibit B to acknowledge they have read and understand the agreement for the handling of Sensitive Law Enforcement Information. Upon completion and return of the signed NDA the DOJ will then work with the specific licensee and/or authorized representative identified by the signed NDA Exhibit B for the disclosure of the appropriate information per the licensee's request.
