


NYC Water Supply

The Watershed Agricultural Council will support the economic viability of agriculture and forestry within the New York City Watershed region while protecting water quality and promoting land conservation.




Watershed Forestry Program

Forestry Program


- •75% of the watershed is forested.

- Number of Forest Management Plans 664
- Total Acreage 110471.1 acres
- Actual Forest Land 85802.9 acre
- DEP Funding \$675,517.90
- USFS Funding \$41,400.51
