The home was a total loss La Salle County **North Portion** 23 0630CST 0 Flash Flood 1130CST Heavy thunderstorms trained across the northern half of La Salle county for several hours during the early morning. Radar estimated widespread 4 to 8 inches fell across the northern half of the county, with a pocket of 9 to 13 inches just north of Cotulla. 7.04 inches was recorded at the Cotulla ASOS. The heavy rainfall led to flash flooding and numerous road closures. A nine-mile stretch of Interstate 35 was closed by Texas DOT, just north of Cotulla to the Frio/La Salle county line, due to flooded sections. Evacuations occurred in northwest La Salle county. Two residents were evacuated by jet ski and three by helicoptor, along a flooded Mustang Creek near Millet. **Mcmullen County South Central Portion** 23 0 0 Flash Flood Heavy showers and thunderstorms from La Salle county spread into McMullen during the morning. Radar estimated between 3 and 5 inches of rain fell across the south-central portion of McMullen county. A NWS cooperative observer recorded 3.12 inches of rainfall. The heavy rainfall led to flash flooding across the area, resulting in some secondary roads covered in water. Cow Creek, 16 miles south of Tilden, flooded F.M. 1962. Webb County

Radar estimated between 3 and 5 inches of rain fell across the southwest portions of Webb county, including southeast portions of Laredo. Significant street flooding occurred across the southeast Laredo. Several stalled cars in high water were reported at the

intersection of Mann Road and Interstate 35 in Laredo.
