None of the funnel clouds touched down. La Salle County Cotulla 22 1725CST Hail(0.88) La Salle County Cotulla 22 1725CST 0 0 Thunderstorm Wind (EG50) Power lines and poles were blown down in Cotulla. **Webb County** 16 SE Laredo 22 1807CST 0 Penny sized hail fell on Higway 83, 6 miles southeast of Rio Bravo, near the Webb/Zapata county line. **Webb County** Aguilares 22 0 0 Flash Flood Portions of State Road 359, Farm to Market Road 2895 and County Road 649 became impassable near Aguilares due to creeks flowing across the roadways.
