POSITION SUMMARY:

Sustainability Multimedia & Outreach Specialist assists efforts on sustainability outreach material, events, and programs, the development of projects, and general assistance with sustainability efforts. The position contributes to the development, design and implementation of outreach materials. The position supports the mission of the Sustainable Development Institute by maintaining and expanding the Institute's online initiatives. This position assists in designing, implementing, and conducting cultural, social, and youth outreach programs as a means for engagement in practices of sustainability.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Develop, design, and implement programs to inform and inspire sustainability practices around campus, community, among youth, and integrating culture. Verify and report the effectiveness of these programs.
- Produce video and multimedia stories and materials for the internet about the efforts of CMN students, faculty and staff that demonstrate leadership and learning about creating a sustainable future.
