

## **Addendum to November 13, 2006 Draft of the CCSP Product 2.1a Report.**

Monday, November 13, 2006

This addendum identifies the substantive changes that have been made to the report since the November 1 Draft. These changes were made in response to public comments that were not addressed in the November 1 Draft.

Note that report is undergoing a final proofreading and technical edit that will result in additional minor grammatical edits, spelling corrections, and clarifications. None of these changes will alter the substance of the report.

ES-1, Line 35-44: The discussion of users and uses of scenarios has been revised.

ES-4, Line 16 through ES-5, Line 8: The discussion of the radiative forcing levels has been revised and the associated table has been revised.

ES-9, Line 23-29: Paragraph has been revised to include material from below.

ES-10, Line 30-34: Paragraph has been deleted and incorporated into ES-9, Line 11-15.

ES-12, Line 22-24: Sentence revised to clarify radiative forcing levels.

ES-12, Line 12-36: Discussion shortened substantially. Longer discussion of this material is included in Chapter 5.

1-1, Line 27-30: Sentence moved up from below for clarity.

1-1, Line 39 through 1-2, Line 3: The discussion of users and uses of scenarios has been revised.

1-2, Line 14-16: Paragraph on users and uses of scenarios incorporated into earlier paragraph.

1-2, Line 18-19: Sentence revised for clarity.

1-3, Line 4-12: Minor edits to paragraph to better explain radiative forcing limits.

1-11, Line 9: Sentences on users of scenarios removed to avoid repetition.

1-14, Line 8-9: Reference revised.

2-9, Line 8-10: Sentence revised for clarity.

3-16, Line 15-17: Sentence added on U.S. fossil and other industrial CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

3-23, 3-24: Ordering of FSU and Eastern Europe adjusted in the Table 3.1 and Table 3.2.

3-36, Figure 3-15: U.S. emissions included in Figure along with corresponding adjustments to the text.

4-1, Line 44-46: Sentences removed referring to existing international agreements and to the relationship between the CO<sub>2</sub> concentrations in the stabilization scenarios and “frequently analyzed levels”.

4-2, Line 40-41: Sentences removed discussing existing international agreements.

4-3, Line 17-19: Sentences removed discussing existing international agreements.

4-16, Line 43 through 4-17, Line 32: Discussion substantially revised for clarity.

4-26, Line 29-30: Reference added.

4-28, Table 4.1: The table and caption have been revised to improve the discussion of the radiative forcing levels used in the study.

4-29, Table 4.3: Caption revised to clarify the relationship between CO<sub>2</sub> concentrations and radiative forcing levels.

4-30, Table 4.5: Values for 2030 were added to the table.

5-3, Line 8-9: Sentence revised for clarity.

5-8, Line 35: Sentence removed.

5-9, Line 1-13: Minor revisions to text for clarity.

5-9, Line 15-30: Text revised for clarity.

5-11, Line 12: Final sentence in paragraph removed.
