



Empowered Parents Stay Involved With School

- ⑤ Learn everything you can about your child's school;
- ⑤ Review the school's handbook and Web site;
- ⑤ Be an advocate for your child and the school;
- ⑤ Ask the principal, vice principal and teachers what the school expects of your child;
- ⑤ Talk with your child's teacher throughout the school year;
- ⑤ Share with teachers what they need to know about your child;
- ⑤ Contact the teacher immediately if your child doesn't understand an assignment or if you notice a change in your child's behavior or school performance;
- ⑤ Participate in orientation nights, parent-teacher meetings and conferences, sports events and art performances;
- ⑤ Volunteer in your child's school as your schedule allows; and
- ⑤ Review how your school did on its Adequate Yearly Progress rating and on its state test scores.
