As presented here, participants who enrolled in postsecondary education likely did so at some point between 2003–04 and 2004–05. UB and UBMS projects do not necessarily become aware of prior participants' postsecondary enrollments until a year or more after the students' high school graduation; moreover, relevant postsecondary financial aid data are not available for analysis until approximately two years after high school graduation. Postsecondary enrollment rates thus tend to increase over several years. Postsecondary enrollment rate is calculated as the number with evidence of postsecondary enrollment divided by the number expected to graduate.
