Re: Federal State Energy Program Funding

I am attaching the relevant provisions of the recently passed American Recovery and Renewal Act of 2009 (H.R.1)(ARRA). As a condition of receiving our State's share of \$3.1 billion in State Energy Program (SEP) funds, our State must demonstrate that we are taking certain actions to begin upgrading building energy codes and develop a plan for compliance. I encourage you to take appropriate steps consistent with this Federal statute. I have also requested the Commissioner of the Office of Energy Resources to work with the appropriate State and local code officials to develop implementation plans.

As a State we are committed to a robust energy efficiency program. This is especially important for buildings that will be part of our housing stock for decades to come.
