# Focus on Existing Relationships and Partnerships

- Most dollars through existing channels
  - -contracts with state or local governments
  - -prior grants or declined applications
  - –ongoing public/private collaborations









Transparent—Requirements for open bidding and/or reporting may extend to subgrantees

#### Prudent—

- Plan for when grant dollars end;
- Sustainable impact
- Public perception
- Challenges of scaling up

Not a good fit for everyone









#### Increases in Existing State Programs e.g.:

- Weatherization—\$23 million, via CAPs
- Early Childhood, \$4.7 million
- Community Health Centers, \$930,000
   May be opportunities to partner

\$50 million for nonprofit capacity bldg to expand delivery of services to children and families affected by recession, geared toward measuring program effectiveness
