Stabilization Funds are going to be used to fully fund state adequacy aid to education. As such these funds are indistinguishable from state funds.





At the same time, it is my understanding that these funds need to be accounted for separately and reported.





### Yes.

Federal law and regulation will require more reporting than has occurred in the past.







The exact character of the reporting that will be required for **ARRA State Fiscal Stabilization** Funds used for adequacy have yet to be determined.







It will be necessary to have a system of segregating ARRA funds sufficiently to document how they have been used.





New Hampshire's Constitution requires that "the State . . . develop a system of accountability to ensure the delivery of a constitutionally adequate public education."

Claremont School Dist. v. Governor, 142 N.H. 462, 477 (1997) (Claremont II).







State officials are working with School officials to develop an appropriate and constitutionally sound accounting and reporting procedure that satisfies federal law and ARRA guidance.





- •What will be the accountability standards to assure that the funds are used as provided in the Stimulus Bill?
- State funds will be tracked with separate revenue and expense codes in the State's accounting system.





# All uses will be publicly posted on NH Recovery Web site

- Bids, RFPs, Grant Opportunities
- All awarded contracts and grants





- State compliance officers from the Office of Economic Stimulus will monitor use and assist with compliance
- Federal Inspectors General have received approximately \$184,000,000 to monitor use nationally





- Recipients of contracts and grants will be required to give federal officials access to records, officials, and staff
- ARRA provides added whistle blower protections





Will school districts be allowed to use the stimulus money to restore significant budget cuts?

Generally, No.

Stimulus funds will assist the State in providing the additional 123 million dollars in adequacy funding

required by State law





Will school districts be allowed to use the stimulus money to restore significant budget cuts?

## Eligible schools will receive additional Title I and IDEA funds

- Limited to permitted uses under federal law
- Spending plans must be approved by State Dept. of Education





Will school districts be allowed to use the stimulus money to restore significant budget cuts?

General Rule: Federal grant funds must be used to supplement, not supplant or replace state/local funds.





Will any of the stimulus money be used toward funding public libraries?

We do not know of any ARRA funded programs providing general funds for public libraries.





Will any of the stimulus money be used toward funding public libraries?

The Broadband appropriation includes funds for competitive grants to promote and expand Internet access at Public Libraries and Community Colleges.



 How do we as a town assist our population in the proper access of weatherization and fuel efficiency funding?

The NH Recovery Web Site will have videos to assist individuals with the process for seeking weatherization.



• How do we as a town assist our population in the proper access of weatherization and fuel efficiency funding?

There currently is a backlog of weatherization requests that will likely exhaust the ARRA weatherization funds.





• How do we as a town assist our population in the proper access of weatherization and fuel efficiency funding?

People who are qualified should nonetheless sign up. Some people with special needs qualify to be moved towards the front of the list.
