## Dear Governor Heineman:

Attached please find the list of transportation projects recommended by the League of Nebraska Municipalities for stimulus funding with funds dedicated to Cities with populations between 5,000 and 199,999 not in an MPO. The League Executive Board endorsed this list yesterday afternoon based on the recommendation of a Subcommittee of former elected officials and persons with expertise in municipal administration.

The Subcommittee developed this list using the concepts of economic need and shovel readiness. The Subcommittee created project funding criteria based on language in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act that provides, "Priority shall be given to projects that are projected for completion within a 3-year time frame and are located in economically distressed areas..."

"...Recipients shall give preference to activities that can be started and completed expeditiously" As required by the law, They utilized the "economically distressed" map located on the Federal Highway Administration website, <a href="http://hepgis.fhwa.dot.gov/hepgis\_v2/GeneralInfo/Map.aspx">http://hepgis.fhwa.dot.gov/hepgis\_v2/GeneralInfo/Map.aspx</a>. Shovel readiness was based on Department of Roads assessment of how many of the required project permits and requirements were already in place or close to completion.

Also, please note that the recommendation also sets aside some funds for cost overruns to be utilized on a first come first serve basis.

I will transmit this information with the proper Department of Roads coding to the appropriate Department officials later this morning.
