Dear Director Orszag:

Under Montana law, federal funds available to our state under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act ("ARRA") cannot be spent without an appropriation for their expenditure by the Montana Legislature. The Legislature has given strong indication of its intent to appropriate ARRA funds to create jobs and promote economic growth in Montana through House Joint Resolution 33, requesting and accepting ARRA funds, which received final approval yesterday. See <http://data.opi.mt.gov/bills/2009/billhtml/HJ0033.htm>. Consequently, I submit the following certification to you.

As Governor of the State of Montana, I hereby certify that: (1) the State of Montana will request and use funds provided by the ARRA; and (2) the funds will be used to create jobs and promote economic growth.

I will continue to monitor the Legislature's enactment of laws appropriating ARRA funds and reserve the right to reject the federal funds in the event that the Legislature's appropriations are not consistent with the intent of ARRA, including state fiscal stabilization.
