On April 8, 2009, the United States Postal Service (the "Postal Service") appointed Vincent DeVito, age 45, as its Vice President, Controller, effective as of April 11, 2009. Mr. DeVito succeeds Lynn Malcolm as Vice President, Controller, who retired from this position effective April 3, 2009.

Mr. DeVito, who is a certified public accountant, has almost 25 years of public- and private-sector financial experience. Since joining the Postal Service in 2005, he has served as Manager, Corporate Accounting, and most recently as Executive Director of our Sarbanes-Oxley implementation group. Prior to that, Mr. DeVito served from 2000 to 2005 as Controller at NiSource Corporate Services, a wholly-owned subsidiary of NiSource, Inc., a publicly traded corporation.
