Digital Copies Search

To limit search results to only those archival descriptions that include digital copies of primary sources, choose the Digital Copies high level search option from any ARC search page.

Enter keywords in the search box and click the Search button.



Viewing Digital Copies Results

ARC displays thumbnail images for the results under the Digital Copies tab.

Click on the thumbnail to see the larger image, or click on "View More Digital Copies" to see additional thumbnails.

Click on the Title to see the full details of the description.




Viewing and Keeping Digital Copies Results

From the larger image view, click on Gallery to view all thumbnails, or click on the Digital Copy navigation to view the next larger image.

Email a description summary and thumbnails.

Print a description summary or the full details and thumbnails.
