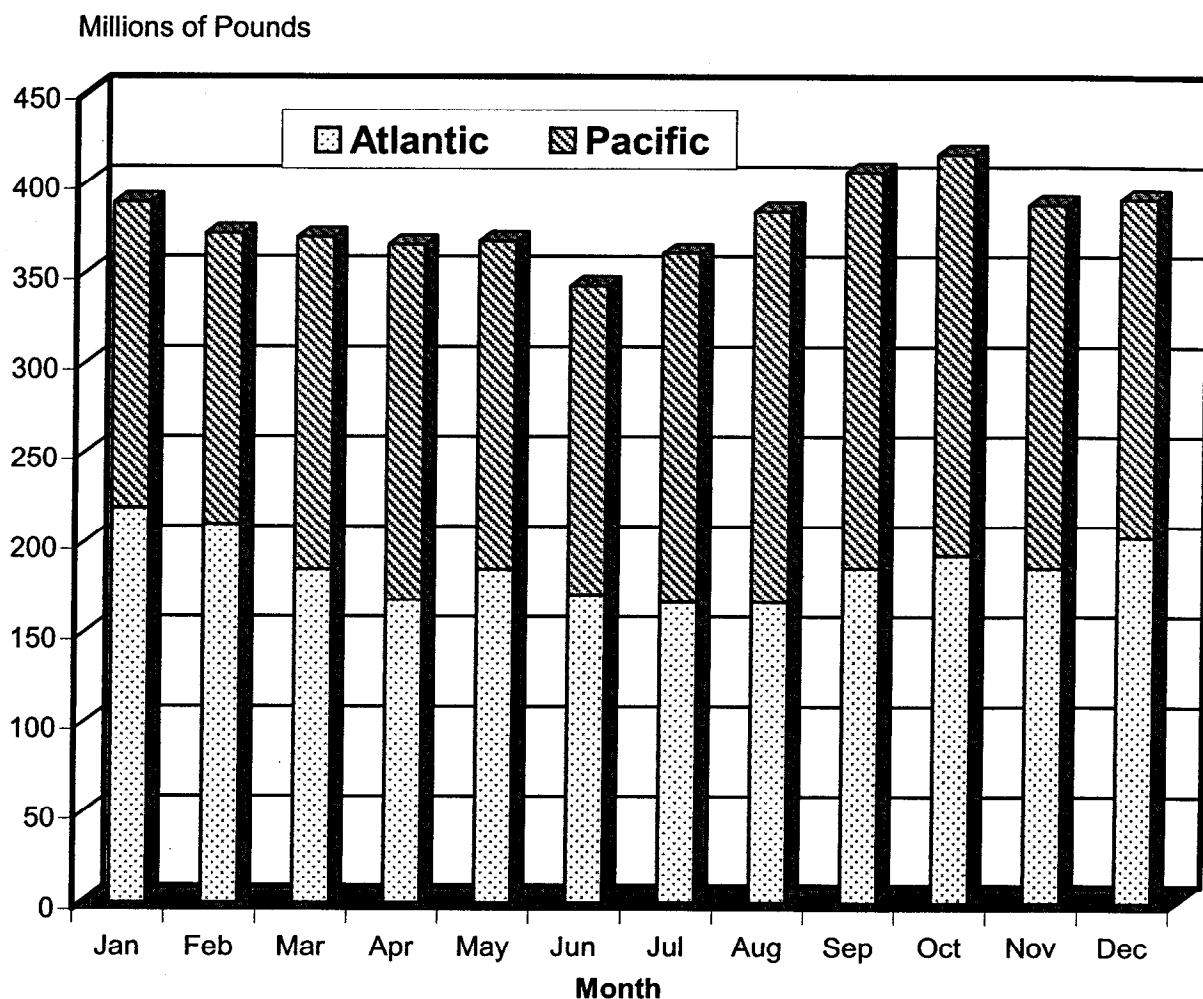

## **REFRIGERATED STORAGE FACILITIES**

Data are voluntarily submitted from warehouses artificially cooled to a temperature of 50 degrees Fahrenheit or lower where whole food products are normally stored for 30 days or more. These includes all types of storage businesses having refrigerated storage space — public, private, or semi-private. All fish items in these facilities are reported regardless of the number of days stored at the time of the report. Also included are specialized facilities meeting the 30 day requirement, such as fish houses, manufacturing and processing plants, frozen fish plants, and packing plants. Excluded are stocks in space maintained by wholesalers, jobbers, distributors, chain stores, locker plants containing individual lockers, and frozen fish processors whose entire inventories are turned over more than once a month.

The key criterion for inclusion in our survey is “normally stored for 30 days or more.” This means they must store fish commodities for that length of time to participate in our program and are requested to report only quantities available on the last day of each month.
