





Expected Range of Vaccine Reactions

- Fatigue
- Headache
- Myalgia
- Lymphadenopathy
- Lymphangitis
- Pruritis
- Edema at the vaccination site
- Satellite Lesions



Rates of Expected Reactions

- 21% complications required physician consult
- Most Common Symptoms
 - ◆ Fatigue (50%)
 - ◆ Headache (40%)
 - ◆ Muscle aches and Chills (20%)
 - ◆ Nausea (20%)
 - ◆ Fever ≥ 37.7 °C or 100 °F (10%)
