COL Michael Johnson. COL Johnson is Art of Design Course Author and School of Advanced Military Studies (SAMS) Advanced Military Studies Program Seminar Leader at Fort Leavenworth, KS. Prior to joining the SAMS staff, COL Johnson served in a variety of assignments with the 3rd Infantry Division and deployed to Iraq three times: as battalion executive officer/brigade S3 in OIF I, as Commander 3rd Squadron 7th U.S. Cavalry in OIF III, and as Division G3 for three months during OIF V.
