# FBI RM Design Principles

- Records Management and Security as fundamental, foundational parts of the enterprise architecture
- Difficult to separate DM from RM in solution
- Have easy access to the information
- Provide that easy access to friends and keep access from enemies
- Provide the means/methods to find desired data easily from managed information



# System Goals

- "Credibility" of the process / system
- "Discipline" of the process – no ability to bypass or work-around
- System provides the discipline rather than relying on adherence to policy and procedure
- "Normal Course of Business"

- Designed and implemented "Electronic Recordkeeping Certification" for all new computer applications
