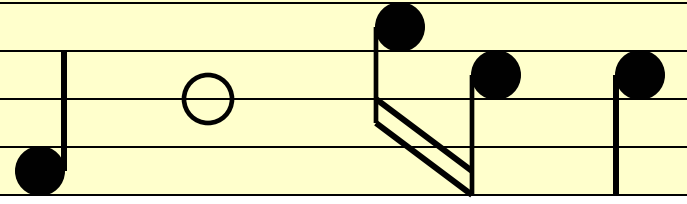


FROM SACRED HARP TO ELVIS:

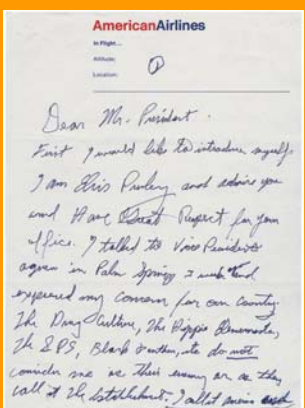
