Approval of District Bank AHP Priority
Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis


WHEREAS, the Federal Housing Finance Board ("Board") has promulgated final regulations at 12 CFR 960 for the Affordable Housing Program ("AHP") that include at 12 CFR 960.5(b)(7) a Federal Home Loan Bank ("Bank") AHP priority recommended by the Bank's Advisory Council, adopted by the Bank's board of directors, and approved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis ("Indianapolis Bank") has submitted a request for approval of a 1991 Bank AHP priority recommended by its Advisory Council and adopted by its board of directors;

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed priority in accordance with Housing Finance Directorate Procedure Memo 91-1, and both the Community Interest Director and the Board staff recommend approval of the Indianapolis Bank 1991 AHP priority;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED, that the Federal Housing Finance Board, pursuant to its authority to administer the AHP under 12 USC 1430 of the Federal Home Loan Bank Act, hereby approves the Indianapolis Bank 1991 AHP priority for "[P]rojects meeting documented critical housing needs as a part of a community revitalization strategy, leveraging AHP funds with other funds, such as Community Investment Program resources" as provided by the resolution adopted at a meeting of the board of directors of the Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis on March 22, 1991.
