Display of Office of Inspector General (OIG) and Office of the

Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA)

Fraud Hotline Posters

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of this AB is to establish procedure for the appropriate display of Office of Inspector General (OIG) and Office of the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration (TIGTA) fraud hotline posters by the bureaus of the Department of the Treasury.

Effective Date: This AB is effective immediately.

Expiration Date: This AB will expire when cancelled or superseded.

Background: FAC 2005-22, effective 12/24/07, established Federal Acquisition Regulation Subpart 3.10, which required display of agency OIG fraud hotline posters.

Action: For any contract that meets the conditions specified in <u>FAR Subpart 3.10</u>, the BCPOs shall ensure display of the appropriate fraud hotline posters as follows by contractors in common work areas within organizations performing work under a contract and on company websites as appropriate:

- 1. All Department of the Treasury bureaus other than the IRS shall include the OIG fraud hotline poster, Attachment 1 Fraud Poster OIG for All Bureaus Except IRS.pdf.
- 2. IRS shall include the TIGTA fraud hotline poster, Attachment 2, Fraud Poster TIGTA for IRS v1.pdf, or Attachment 3, Fraud Poster TIGTA for IRS v2.pdf.
