WHEREAS, The Federal Home Loan Bank Board Resolution No. FHFB 89-13 dated October 16, 1989, approved the sale of \$3,977,000,000 par amount of the Federal Home Loan Bank Consolidated Discount Notes for the period October 19, 1989, through November 15, 1989. The following is a schedule of discount notes sold for the period October 11, 1989, through November 3, 1989.

Of this amount. \$131,140,000 will be issued November 6, 1989, and \$50,000,000 will be issued November 7, 1989.

WHEREAS, As authorized in Federal Home Loan Bank Board Resolution No. 88-32 dated January 21, 1988, the Federal Home Loan Bank Medium Term Bond program sold \$34,090,000 bonds, as shown in the following schedule, in the period October 11, 1989, through November 3, 1989. Of this amount, \$6,555,000 will be issued in the period November 6, 1989, through November 10, 1989. There are now \$931,420,000 Medium Term Bonds outstanding.

WHEREAS, The Federal Housing Finance Board has been advised by the Director, Office of Finance, of the consolidated obligation financing requirements for the forthcoming period, and that \$225,000,000 Series QQ-1989 (9.115%) will mature November 20, 1989, and \$320,000,800 Series E-1989 (11.550%), \$675,000,000 Series S-1989 (6.600%), \$1,720,000,000 Series Y-1989 (8.125%), and \$1,150,000,000 Series RR-1989 (8.800%) will mature November 27, 1989.

RESOLVED, That the Federal Housing Finance Board authorized discount note offerings of up to \$2,232,000,000 for the period from November 16, 1989, to November 30, 1989, and an amount of \$1,552,000,000 (1/2 of the December request) from December 1, 1989, through December 13, 1989, at rates up to 12.00%. In addition, at the same time, the Federal Housing Finance Board authorized an emergency amount for contingencies of up to \$2,000,000,000 at rates up to 12.00%

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Federal Housing Finance Board authorized Medium Term Bond offerings of up to \$1,000,000,000 for the period from November 16, 1989, to December 13, 1989.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, That the issuance of consolidated Federal Home Loan Bank Bonds, as follows:

is hereby prescribed and authorized in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Federal Home Loan Bank Act, as amended, and Part 506 of the General Regulations of the Federal Home Loan Bank Board, (contained in FIRREA, Title IV, Sec. 402 (h)) and subject to the provisions of Section 303 of the Government Corporation Control Act so far as applicable.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That bonds of said Series JJ-1990, Series Y-1992, Series K-1994, and Series K-1996 shall be dated November 27, 1989. All bonds shall be in book-entry form, shall be non-callable, and shall be issued in minimum amounts of \$10,000 and multiples of \$5,000.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Director, Office of Finance of the Federal Home Loan Banks, the Deputy Director, Office of Finance of the Federal Home Loan Banks, or the Manager, Debt Management Division, Office of Finance of the Federal Home Loan Banks, on behalf of the Board, is hereby authorized and directed to effect the sale for cash of bonds of said series in amounts not exceeding those set forth in this resolution, provided, that said Director, Office of Finance, the Deputy Director, Office of Finance, or Manager, Debt Management Division, Office of Finance, may allow a concession of not to exceed \$1.00 per \$1,000 par value of Series JJ-1990 bonds, \$1.75 per \$1,000 par value of Series Y-1992 bonds, \$2.00 per \$1,000 par value of Series K-1994 bonds, and \$2.50 per \$1,000 par value of Series K-1996 bonds to dealers and dealer banks.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Director, Office of Finance, the Deputy Director, Office of Finance, or the Manager, Debt Management Division, Office of Finance is authorized to establish the terms and prices of the above consolidated bond issues whose prices shall not exceed 100 basis points above the rates on comparable securities, i.e., U.S. Treasury, on November 14, 1989, for Series JJ-1990, Series Y-1992, Series K-1994, and Series K-1996. The prices, terms, and other such actions shall be reported to this Board or successor as soon as practicable.

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RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Director, Office of Finance, the Deputy Director, Office of Finance, or the Manager, Debt Management Division, Office of Finance, is hereby authorized in the notice offering the above described obligations in behalf of the Board to include the following:

Subscriptions will be accepted from selling group members at the office of the undersigned, who, reserves the right to close the books as to any or all subscriptions or classes of subscriptions at any time without notice. The right is reserved to the undersigned to reject any subscription, in whole or in part, to allot less than the amount of consolidated obligations applied for, to make allotments in full upon applications for smaller amounts, to make reduced allotments upon, or to reject, applications for larger amounts, and to make different percentage allotments to members of the established selling groups, and action in any or all of these respects shall be final.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Director, Office of Finance, the Deputy Director, Office of Finance, or the Manager, Debt Management Division, Office of Finance, shall have authority to take such steps and issue such instructions from time to time as may be necessary or proper to effect the purposes and provisions of this resolution, including the sale and delivery of consolidated obligations in accordance with the foregoing provisions hereof and the deposit of the proceeds thereof in appropriate accounts with the Federal Reserve Bank of New York. The functions vested by this resolution in said Director may be exercised also by the Deputy Director or the Manager, Debt Management Division of said Office.
