Plains Exploration & Production Company (PXP) and the State of California, Division of Oil, Gas & Geothermal Resources invite local teachers and selected students to tour an offshore Platform.

This is an opportunity to see up close how offshore oil and gas are produced and transported to shore.

Travel to/from the platform via a Sikorski S-76 twin-turbine helicopter. This helicopter ride will last approximately 15 to 20 minutes each way.

Once onboard the platform, you will have an opportunity to tour the entire "mini-city" including living quarters, control room and other key process areas. An all-you-can-eat lunch will be served in the galley.

During your tour, there will likely be opportunities to view various types of sea life under and around the platform including possibly dolphins, sea lion, sea turtles, whales and various fish and birds.

All participants should be capable of going up and down multiple flights of stairs. Due to federal regulations regarding emergency breathing air onboard the platform, **NO** facial hair is allowed if it would interfere with the facemask of breathing equipment. All participants must be clean-shaven of beards, long sideburns and mustaches.

In the extremely unlikely event that weather prohibits the helicopter from departing the platform as scheduled, an overnight stay on the platform may be necessary. The platform is well equipped to provide adequate food and lodging needs.
