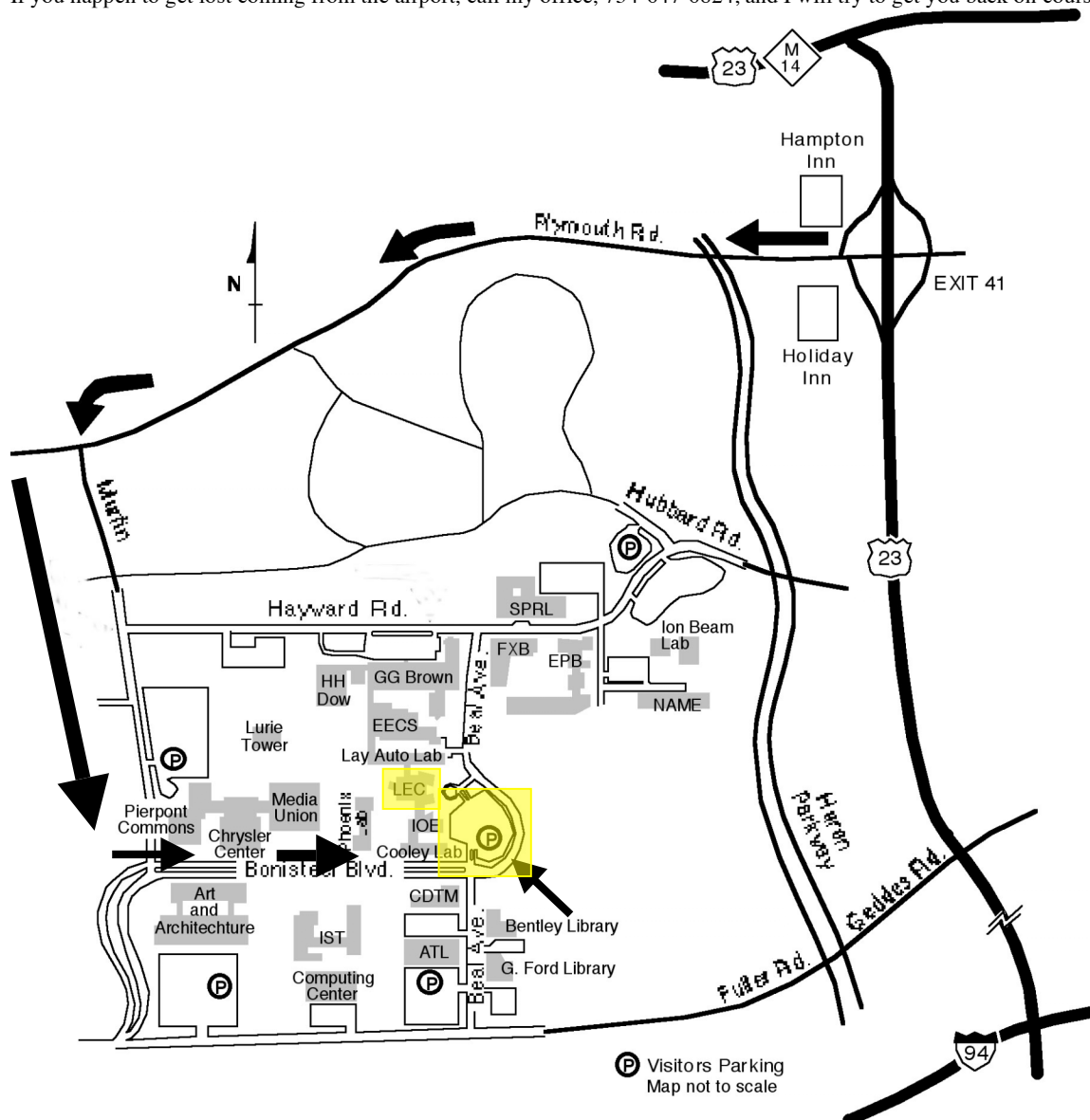

- From Detroit Metro Airport follow the signs to interstate highway I-94 going west, as if you were driving to Chicago.
- Continue west on I-94 until you reach the intersection with highway US-23. At the intersection follow the signs for US-23 going North.
- Continue on US-23 to Exit # 41
- Take Exit 41 off of US-23 onto Plymouth Road. Stay in the left turn lane of the exit ramp to make the turn onto Plymouth Road.
- Travel west on Plymouth Road, remaining in the leftmost lane. Shift to the left turn lane as you approach the intersection with Huron Parkway where you will turn left (at the traffic light).
- Travel south on Huron Parkway to the next traffic light and turn right on Hubbard
- When Hubbard splits off to the Northwest (right), at the first stop sign, continue on the Southwest branch (Hayward). Go past the left turn for Beal Avenue (at the second stop sign).
- Take the first driveway on the left after you pass Beal Avenue. This is the G G Brown parking lot.
- If you cannot find a parking space in this lot, temporarily park near the front (double) door of the G G Brown Building. Go inside to the main office (first office inside the doors) and ask for your temporary parking permit (I will arrange for this ahead of your arrival). While you are there ask the receptionist to call me and notify me that you have arrived. The receptionist should be able to guide you to other parking lots that are nearby. Once you have parked your car, return to the G G Brown Building, and I will assist you from that point.

If you happen to get lost coming from the airport, call my office, 734-647-6824, and I will try to get you back on course.

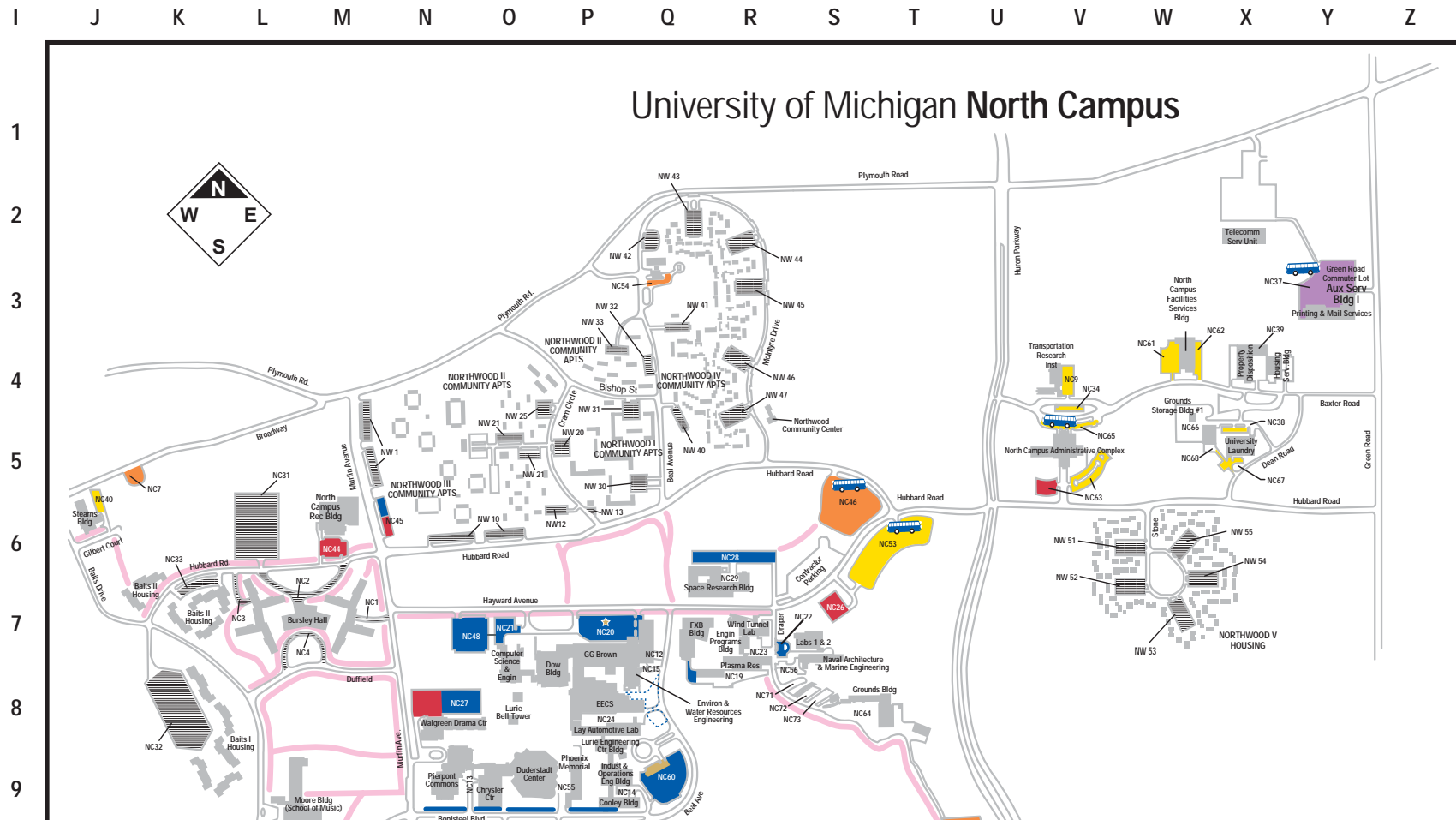

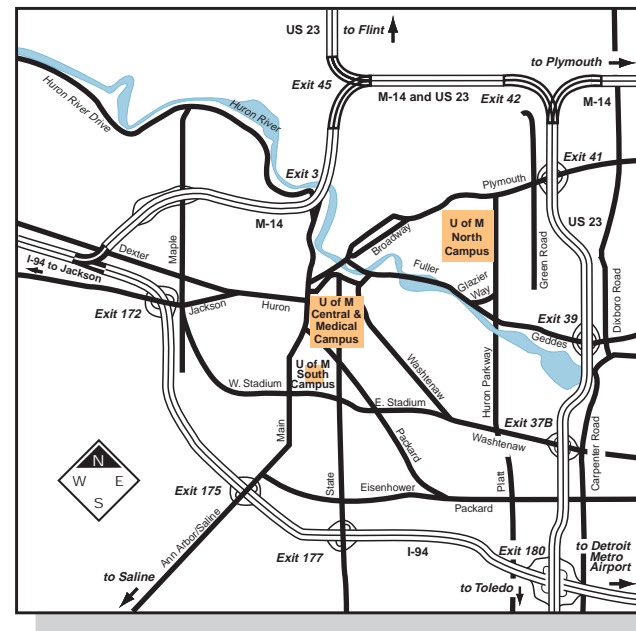
