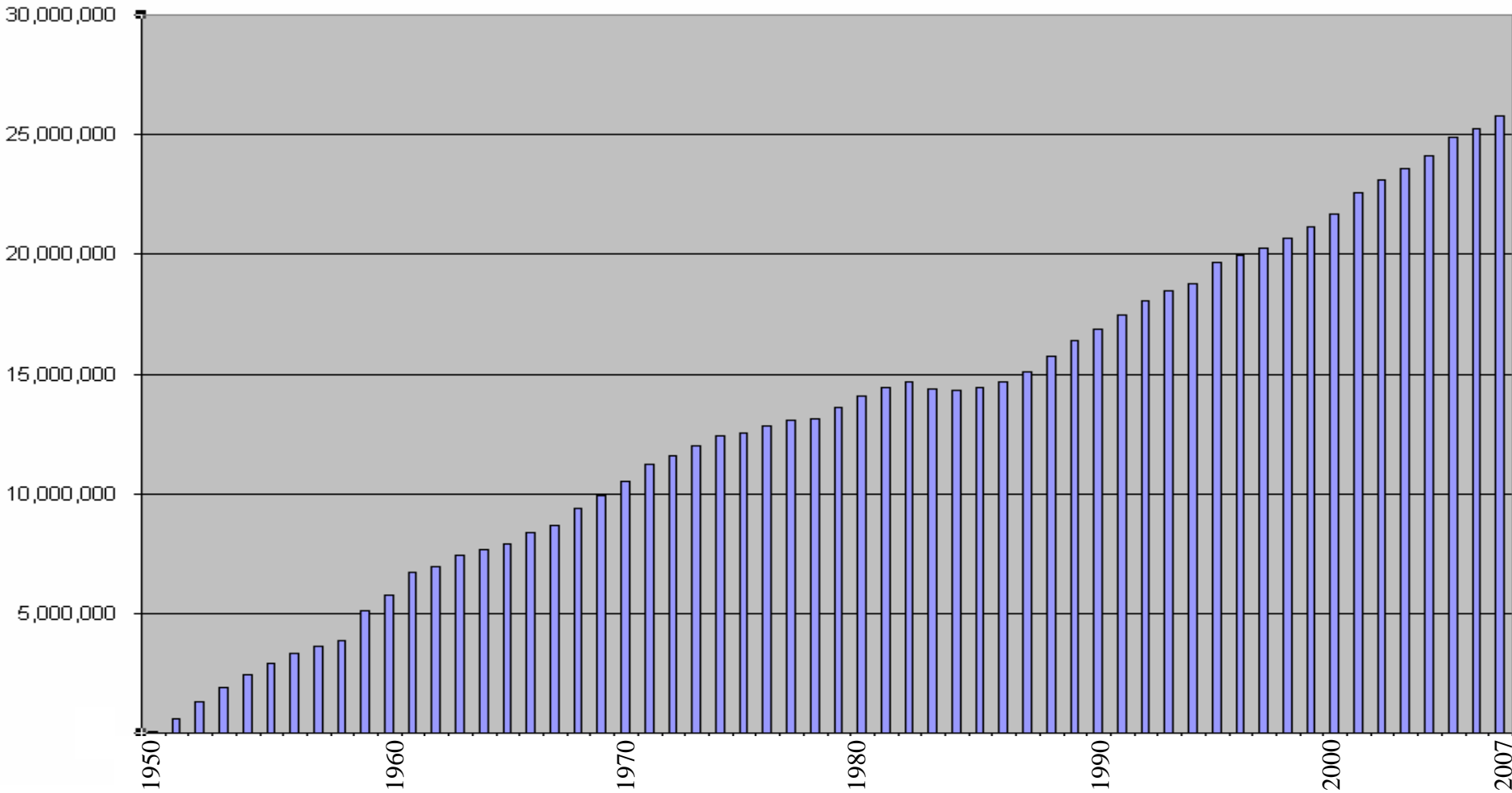

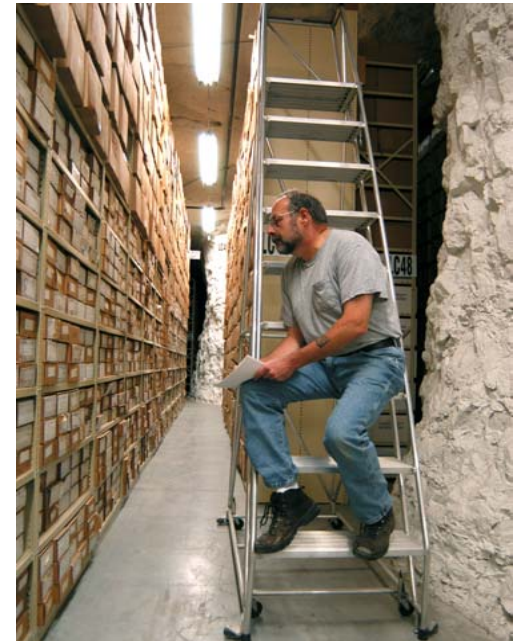

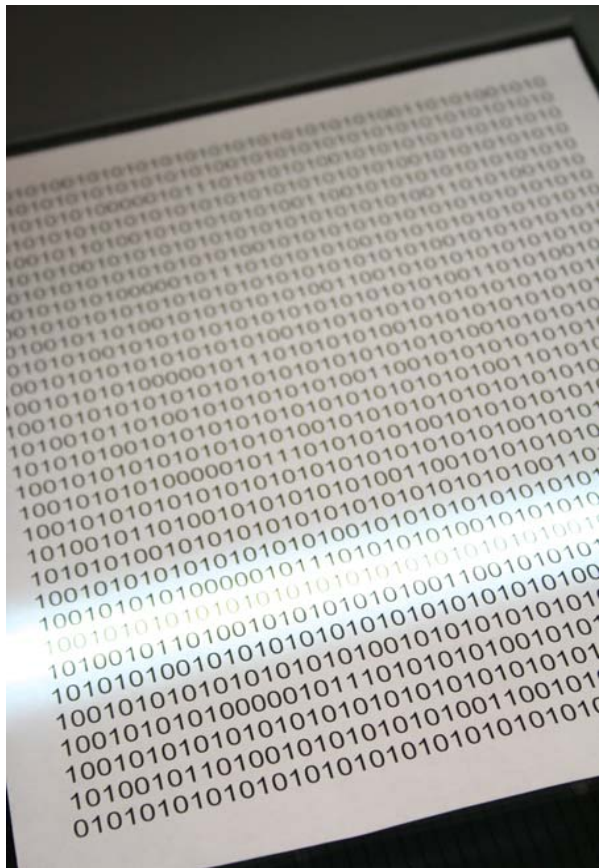
# Services—e-media destruction
