

Mississippi, 2005

Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** Mississippi reported 49 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Mississippi ranked 26 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 1.7 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Mississippi, the rate among males was 2.6 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.8 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Racial disparities of primary and secondary syphilis

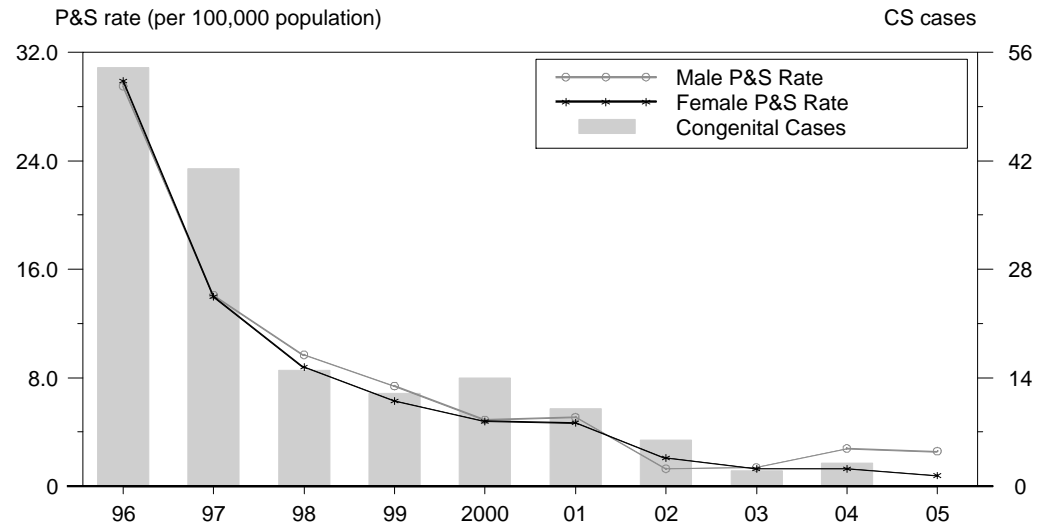
In Mississippi, the race/ethnicity adjusted rates per 100,000 population were 0.5 among whites, 3.7 among blacks, 0.0 among Hispanics, 4.3 among Asian/Pacific Islanders, and 0.0 among American Indians/Alaska Natives.

- The rate among blacks was 7.4 times that of whites.
- The rate among Asian/Pacific Islanders was 8.6 times that of whites.

Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** Mississippi reported 0 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Mississippi had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
