The process to be used to identify, develop, and implement dissemination activities

The types of activities to be used The budget for implementing the dissemination plan The dissemination plan budget is to be included in the last year of requested funding and that dissemination activities may continue under a one-year no cost extension

An explicit statement that the offeror agrees to discuss and finalize the dissemination plan with Institute staff prior to its implementation

2. Revise the Table of Contents, item 2. Background/Statement of Work to correct the following under Phase 2 (Recruitment - 3 years and Follow-up - 2 years (60 months):

Delete: Approximately 5,000 patients will be recruited over 24 months by at least 100 sites.

Insert: Approximately 5,000 patients will be recruited over 36 months with 24 months of follow-up, by at least 100 sites.

3. Revise the Table of Contents, item 11. Instructions Conditions and Notices to Offerors, -Specific to this RFP, under General Information, Estimate of Effort to correct a typographical error as follows:

Delete: Phase II (1 year)

Insert Phase III (1 year)

Phase I (6 Mos) and Phase II (5 years) remain as originally stated.

4. Revise the Table of Contents, item 11. Instructions, Conditions, and Notices to Offerors- Specific to this RFP, General Information to add the following information:

Page and Formatting Limitations

The Technical Plan (objectives, approach, methods, procedures, and schedule) of the Technical Proposal shall not exceed 30 single-sided pages or 15 double-sided pages. This page limitation does not apply to the cover sheet, abstract, table of contents, personnel, facilities, equipment and resources, other considerations, other support, cost information and literature cited. Appendices shall be limited to 50 single-sided pages or 25 double-sided pages. Pages in excess of this will be deleted and will be neither read nor evaluated. Each page of the Technical Proposal must be number sequentially. Offerors are encouraged to limit the overall size of the Technical Proposal, inclusive of appendices, attachments, etc. Note that although there is no page limitation on the Business Proposal, offerors are encouraged to limit its content to only those documents necessary to provide adequate support for the proposed costs.

Type density and size must be 10 to 12 points. If constant spacing is used, 15 cpi (characters per inch) or fewer shall be used whereas proportional spacing should provide an average of no more than 15 cpi. There must be no more than six lines of text within a vertical inch. Margins must be set no less than 2 inch around, exclusive of headers or footers.
