Agency Contracting Officers may submit one-time written request for authorization to use a contract(s) to the Contracting Officer identified in Item 2 above. Authorization is at the discretion of the Government.
- Fair Opportunity to Compete (Section <u>G.4</u>):
 Contracting Officers placing orders shall provide each contractor a fair opportunity to be considered for each order exceeding \$2,500 issued under any of the above contracts, except as provided in <u>FAR 16.505(b)(2)</u>.

The following may be considered in fulfilling the requirement:

- Competition methodology based on best value, availability, pricing, technical considerations, etc.
- Email RFQs
- Verbal RFQs
- Logical follow-on <u>only</u> if original equipment was purchased under one of these LMR contracts and all eligible contractors were given a fair opportunity to compete on the original order.
- Contract Term: Base Year (September 12, 2002 through September 30, 2003), First Option Year (October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004), Second Option Year (October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005), Third Option Year (October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006), Fourth Option (October 1, 2006 through September 11, 2007).
- Geographic Scope: Contiguous United States; Alaska; Hawaii; District of Columbia; Guam; Virgin Islands; Puerto Rico; American Samoa; and Northern Marianas, depending upon the contract.
- 8. Ordering: Each authorized user is responsible for the issuance and administration of and payment for delivery orders for its requirements. The terms and conditions of the contract apply to each delivery order issued thereunder. Every effort should be made to resolve issues, if any, between the authorized user and the Contractor. However, the COTR and Contracting Officer should be contacted in the event all efforts are unsuccessful.

All authorized users are responsible for maintaining a record of the orders placed and the related process in the event of an audit.

- Section 508 Compliance: Waived. Determination and Findings and supporting rationale. See link to D&F under Section 508 Information.
- 16. Minimum Background Investigation (MBI): The contracts, paragraph H.14 permit the Government to conduct MBIs when applicable.
