Dear Mr. President:

Enclosed is a draft bill to amend the Communications Act of 1934 to provide the Federal Communications Commission with permanent authority to auction spectrum licenses and with new authority to charge fees for unauctioned spectrum licenses and construction permits.

Spectrum auctions have proven to be an efficient method for assigning licenses or permits for certain spectrum-based services. Making the Commission's auction authority permanent will allow for more certainty in the auction planning process in the coming years. Fees on unauctioned spectrum licenses can be a desirable spectrum management tool in certain circumstances. Providing the Commission with fee authority will promote more efficient and effective spectrum use.

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) estimates that this proposal would increase receipts by \$10 million in 2005 and by \$4 billion over ten years, though final scoring of enacted legislation may differ from these estimates. We have been advised by OMB that enactment of this legislative proposal would be in accord with the program of the President.
