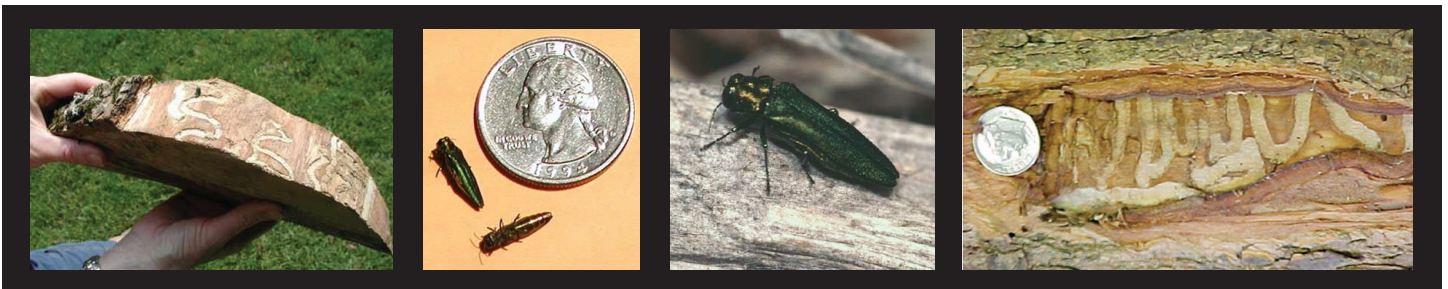
- **Use local sources of firewood**
