

New Foreign Trade Regulation Requirements

New Requirements, Tougher Penalties

On October 1, 2008, the Census Bureau began requiring mandatory filing of export information through the Automated Export System (AES) or through the online AESDirect program for all shipments where a paper Shipper's Export Declaration was required. Penalties may be imposed per violation of the Foreign Trade Regulation (FTR) from \$1,100 to \$10,000—both civil and criminal—for the delayed filing, failure to file, false filing of export information, and/or using the AES to further any illegal activity. Also, all AES filers now face new filing deadlines by mode of transportation for reporting export information.

Avoid Costly Penalties and Seizures

It is imperative that you understand these new requirements and how to avoid possible penalties and seizure of your commodities. To this end, the U.S. Census Bureau's Foreign Trade Division and the U.S. Commercial Service are offering the following series of webinars to educate U.S. exporters on these new regulations.
