

# ***Coral Reef Friendly Tips***

1. **If you bring it, don't leave it.** Bring extra plastic bags to pick up trash at the beach.

2. **Reduce** the amount of waste you produce, reuse what you can, and recycle.

3. Don't take **anything** from Marine Protected Areas. Elsewhere, don't take too many shells from one place.

4. **Look but don't touch.** In the water, take only pictures, and leave only bubbles. Collecting live or dead corals is **illegal**.

5. **Walk it, don't drive it!**

Driving and parking on the beach is illegal.

6. **Conserve** water and energy.

7. **Walk, bike, carpool** and **drive less** to reduce carbon emissions.

8. **Volunteer** for beach and reef cleanups.

9. **Inform** your friends and family, and **work together** to protect our reefs.
