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ADVANCE REPORT ON RETAIL TRADE, MAY 1958

Total sales of retail stores in May were \$17.3 billion, the U. S. Department of Commerce announced today. This advance figure, after adjustment for seasonal factors and trading day differences was virtually unchanged from April and 1 percent below May 1957.

The May sales figures are based on the Advance Report on Retail Trade, a monthly survey of the Bureau of the Census conducted in cooperation with a representative cross-section of about 1,700 retail firms which, in total, operate some 35,000 stores in the United States. The firms which are cooperating in the early reporting of sales are part of a larger group which furnishes figures at a later date. The advance estimates are preliminary and subject to revision, but the revision of the total seldom exceeds 12 percent.

The preliminary Census figures for May are shown in table 1 on the reverse side. The Office of Business Economics noted that after adjustment for seasonal factors and trading day differences, retail sales in May showed little change from April in both the durable and nondurable goods groups. Small offsetting changes were indicated for the various major groups.
