United States citizenship is required.

Location: Washington, DC area.

Duration: Two years, but can be extended with special considerations.

Starting salaries expected to be from \$73,000 to \$93,000 with adjustments depending on Salary:

qualifications and experience.

Benefits: Federal health and life insurance, sick and annual leave available, 401(k) equivalent, and

relocation expenses paid in some cases.

Application A curriculum vitae.

Materials: Official transcripts of all graduate and undergraduate credits.

Three reference letters.

Research proposal prepared in accordance with the guidelines given on the Web sites below.

Application For fullest consideration, submit to agency by January 30.

Deadline: Decisions will be made beginning mid-March.

mid-May and the end of December.
