
The conference will address the relevant issues via papers, panels of speakers and audiovisual presentations.

A block of rooms has been reserved for conference participants at the Ramada Inn, 8400 Wisconsin Ave., Bethesda, MD.


The Ramada is within walking distance of the National Library of Medicine's Lister Hill Center (LHC), where the conference will take place.
